PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE:

Mr. Spriggs is the son and nephew of licensed surveyors, and has been helping or around surveying most of his life. He currently performs topographic and control survey as a single operator and joins other crews in performing mostly design level topographic mapping for engineering purposes.

He is familiar with Trimble and Topcon GPS, static and RTK systems; TDS Ranger and Topcon FC200 data collectors; and, Topcon Robotic and Nikon total stations. He has performed data collection and ran control traverses on projects as small as a single building lot to 500 acre boundaries. He has collected topographic and R/W data for engineering design on pipelines over 5 miles in length. He has performed some construction staking mostly on residential and commercial new construction and has performed the survey calculations for the staking.

In the office, Mr. Spriggs meets with clients and helps prepare estimates for new work and schedules workload. He also performs network adjustments and AutoCAD mapping including TIN and DTM creation. He has prepared Record of Surveys, Parcel Maps, Certificates of Correction, Abandonment documents and legal descriptions.
